



### IRC League: General Rules and Regulations

1. If a team registered for a Nationals and fails to show up, in that case the registration fee will be forfeited.
2. Team should have **minimum 2 and Max 4 members**. Team Member names should be same as per the registration. No change in team members will be allowed after registration.
3. Registration and payment for the Nationals closes on **14<sup>th</sup> December at 12:00 PM**.
4. Students have to come in School uniform on the competition day and should also **carry their School ID proofs as it will be verified on event day**.
5. Students should adhere to eligibility criteria as on website ([http://ircleague.com/challenge\\_eligibility.php](http://ircleague.com/challenge_eligibility.php)).
6. Teams/parents/teachers/visitors will be provided with their respective accreditation cards and entry in the competition venue is subject to showing proper accreditation. Refreshment will be provided only to the team participants and accompanying teacher – parents accompanying the children or visitors can purchase food from the food stalls at the venue.
7. **Visitors/Teachers and parents will be asked to sit at their designated area** and will not be allowed to enter into the arena area at any point of time.
8. Teachers/ Parents are not allowed to interfere during the actual robot run, any obstruction by the anyone in the actual run would result in disqualification of the team from the tournament.
9. If Students are not satisfied with referee's help, he/she may approach the chief referee with the help of a Conflict/complaint form within **10 minutes** of the actual robot run.
10. A **trial run (only for Middle and Senior)** will be provided on the trial arena only from **7:00AM to 9:00AM**.
11. Teams may have a look at their respective referee sheet to help them understand scoring rules in a better way.

13. Total scoring in Nationals will be the addition of **Objective (Arena run)** and **Subjective (Presentation)** scoring (the same would be communicated well in advance).
14. After the actual robot run, teams should sign their referee sheet (mandatory).
15. If the teams have finished all the tasks on the arena, the props would be refurbished onto the arena again and any additional scores gained such would be added to their overall tally.
16. Note: Refurbishing would only happen if the team has **succeeded in completing all the tasks**. Refurbishing has to be done by the referee only. Refurbishing time will not be counted.
17. Any behavior of the teachers/team/coach/parent/visitor that does not support the spirit of the Robotic competition values is highly unwelcomed and we, at IRC League, always believe in healthy discussions if doubts arise but not at the expense of delaying the competition or vilifying the environment.
18. Referee/Judges decision is final and binding.
19. In case if you have any grievance or dispute, please lodge the same with the **Chief Referee**. A fee of Rs.700/- will be charged for the same. The Chief Referee would then take the final call on the complaint/grievance. **Video shoot of the Arena run is mandatory** as a proof to make your stated position.
20. Robots made by a team for one level **cannot be used by another team** (of the same School or any other school) for same/ different level in the same competition. If found so, both the teams involved would be disqualified.
21. If any material is lost of participants (Manual/Electronic) during competition, then IRC is not responsible.
22. Transportation of students is not IRC management responsibility.
23. We will not be providing any kind of electronic support at venue.
